**INVITATION TO SUBMIT
COMPARATIVE PROPOSALS**

Joint Venture Operation on the Design and Building/Construction of a Waste Processing Facility (through Garbage Conversion to Electricity Technology in Olongapo City Sanitary Landfill)

The City Government of Olongapo ("CGO") received an Unsolicited Proposal for the Design and Building/Construction of a Waste Processing Facility (through Garbage Conversion to Electricity Technology-GCtE) in Olongapo City Sanitary Landfill with an aggregate area of more or less fifteen (15) hectares.

The CGO, pursuant to its power to grant Joint Venture with private sector and enter into Agreements under Ordinance No. 04, Series of 2019, otherwise known as "Olongapo City P4 Code", invites the public, through its Public-Private Partnership for People's Initiative Selection Committee ("P4-SC"), to submit their comparative proposals for the joint venture operation on the design and building/construction of a waste processing facility through garbage conversion to electricity technology in Olongapo City Sanitary Landfill (*Swiss Challenge*).

Prospective Proponents must submit the following **legal requirements** to the P4-SC:

- 1) SEC Registration Certificate;
- 2) Valid and current Mayor's Permit;
- 3) BIR Registration Certificate containing the Prospective Proponent's Tax Identification Number;
- 4) Omnibus Sworn Statement stating that the Prospective Proponent is not blacklisted or barred from bidding by the Government, as supported by a CIAP Certificate; and
- 5) Tax Clearance.

In addition, the Prospective Proponent must possess the following **technical requirements**:

- 1) The Prospective Proponent must have completed and currently operating at least two (2) projects similar or related to the Project activity whose value must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the cost of the Project activity;
- 2) The Prospective Proponent must have a minimum experience of five (5) years in the business of operating and constructing a waste processing facility through garbage conversion to electricity; and
- 3) The Prospective Proponent shall submit a statement of all its ongoing and completed government and private contracts similar or related to the Project activity.

Lastly, the Prospective Proponent shall submit the following documentary requirements in support of its **financial capability**:

- 1) Audited Financial Statements for the past three (3) calendar years showing an average paid-up capital of at least two hundred million pesos (P3,000,000,000.00); and
- 2) Latest Income Tax Returns.

The comparative proposals shall be subject to the terms and conditions prescribed in the Terms of Reference (TOR) prepared by the CGO. The TOR will be available only to Prospective Proponent upon payment of a non-refundable amount of one hundred thousand pesos (P500,000.00). Only those who have purchased the TOR shall be allowed to participate in the pre-selection conference and opening and evaluation of proposals.

If no expression of interest from any Prospective Proponent is submitted on the last day of the submission of the eligibility documents and letter of intent, the Competitive/Swiss Challenge shall be deemed terminated and the Project shall be awarded to the Original Proponent.

The CGO reserves the right to reject any or all bids, declare failure of bidding and not to award the contract for any justifiable and reasonable ground where an award will not redound to the benefit of the CGO.
